Malta

September is still warm in Malta. The average high temperature is 28°C (83°F), and the average low temperature is 21°C (70°F).



Travel

FLIGHT AVAILABILITY

Our recommendation would be to fly to Malta International Airport. Several major airlines serve Malta and there are daily flights from Manchester, London Luton and London Stansted. Airlines include: British Airways, Jet 2, and Ryanair. Direct flights from London airports to Malta Airport are available throughout the morning on Fridays in September. Direct return flights from Malta Airport to London Airports are available on Sundays during September.

AIRPORT TRANSFERS

Malta International Airport is located 9.5 kilometres from Corinthia Palace Hotel. The transfer time is 20 minutes.

TAXI

The taxi rank is just outside the terminal building, there is signage inside, and the taxis are easy to find. A taxi from Malta Airport to Corinthia Palace is from €20.00 each way.

Corinthia Palace is located in the heart of the island of Malta, adjacent to the Presidential Palace and public San Anton botanical gardens, the 147-room five-star hotel exudes authentic grace and classical charm. 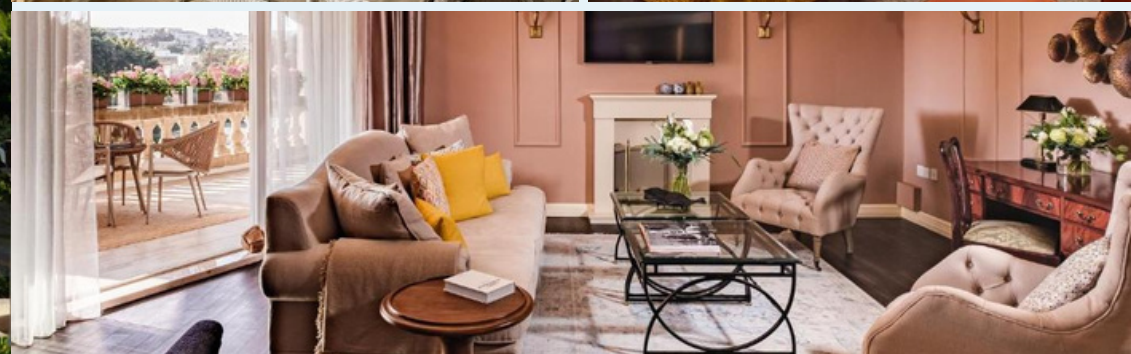

Our Gala Dinner will be held in the Ballroom.

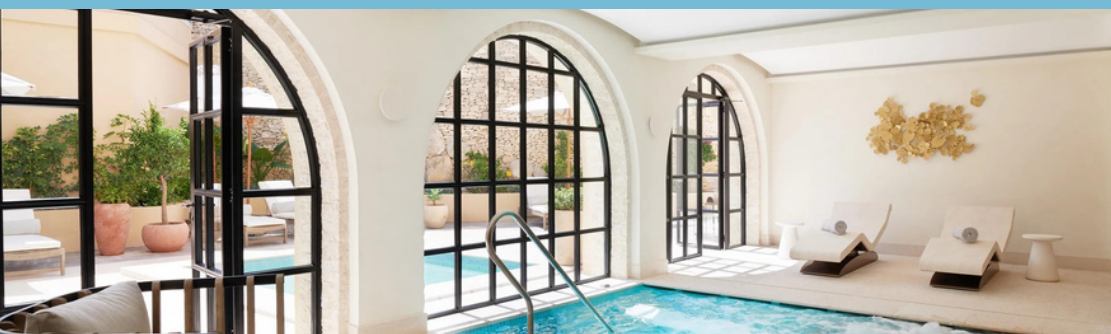
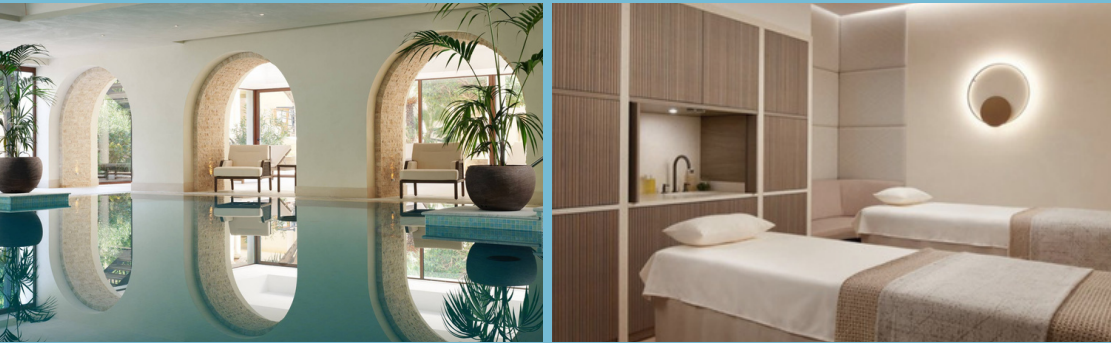
